Your submission should include the following:

1. A completed application form (below)
2. DVD, Blu-Ray, Hardcopy or Private Vimeo link of your film.
3. A trailer of your film. This can be added to the DVD, Blu-ray, Hardcopy or Vimeo or emailed to info@cafilmfestival.ca as a .mov file. Trailers will be used to advertise the Film Festival.
4. Submit the above materials to Central Alberta Film Festival office.

If you are sending your submission by mail, please allow enough time for it to arrive by midnight on September 1, 2016.

Deadline for late submissions is September 19, 2016.

We accept any genre and style of film. Shorts & feature length films, documentaries and experimental films are all welcome.

If our Selection Committee deems it necessary, they may re-classify submissions.
